Cherney Maribel Caves County Park occupies 75 acres on the West Twin River with a rugged cliff line, generally paralleling the river, containing small caves and openings in the rock layers, and partially wooded upland area. The upland wooded area and its fringes have been developed with facilities for picnicking, hiking, biking and a playground. A staircase and trail system has been constructed for greater accessibility to the scenic lowland area. New Hope Cave is the largest, most extensive cave and is only open during tour times.
