Lake Data

Surface area: 50.64 acres

Max depth: 90 feet

Shore length: 1.12 miles

Lake type: Deep seepage. Deep seepage lakes stratify, or form separate layers of water, during the summer months and have no inlet or outlet.

Bottom: 15% sand, 5% gravel, 80% muck

Verified aquatic invasive species: banded mystery snail (2012), curly-leaf pondweed (2007), Eurasian water-milfoil (2009), hybrid Eurasian / northern water-milfoil (2011).

Fish present: Largemouth Bass and Bluegill are common. Northern Pike, Walleye, Perch, and other panfish are also present.

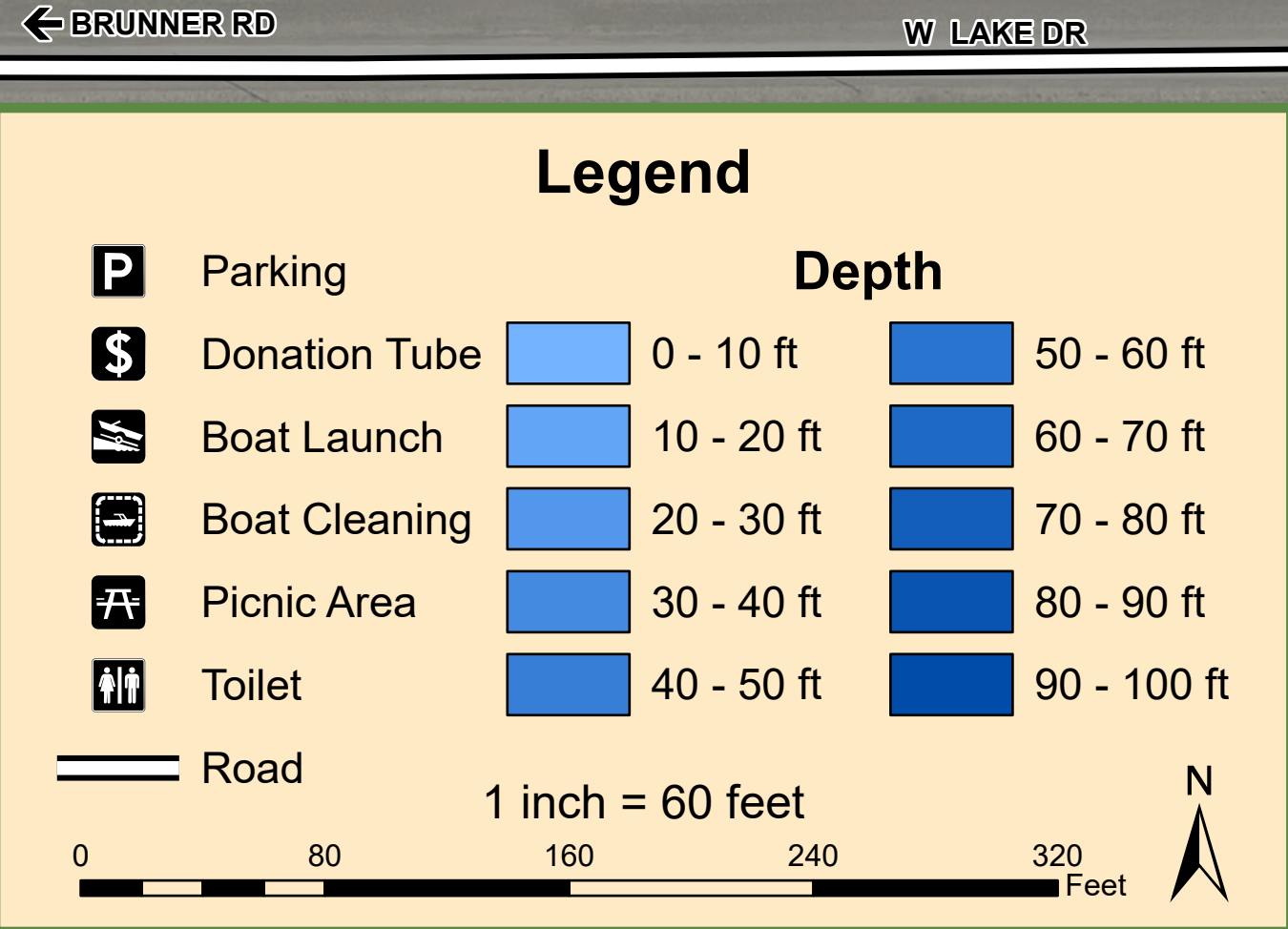
