



## **Guidelines for Dairy Cattle Clipping at the Manitowoc County Fair**

1. Dairy clipping in the Main Cattle Barn at the Manitowoc County Fair is designed to be an educational process where less experienced youth have the opportunity to learn from more experienced youth, leaders, and/or parents.
2. Clipping in the Main Cattle Barn must be done by the exhibitor, owner of the dairy cattle, family member, or youth organization advisor or organization member.
3. Those conducting the clipping are responsible for cleaning up after themselves, including hair, clipping/fitting supplies, etc.
4. All electrical cords must be according to code (All plugs must be secure, no bare areas, and no taped cords).
5. Disciplinary action may occur if these guidelines are not followed. For example, premiums may be forfeited for the current year for both Junior Fair and Open Class exhibitors, and Junior Fair Herdsmanship points may be deducted for any organization that violates the rules.
6. Furthermore, the clipping guidelines described above will be conducted on a trial basis. Failure to follow the guidelines will result in no clipping allowed in the Main Cattle Barn.
7. These guidelines have been set up for the safety of all of our Fair patrons and exhibitors.
8. Clipping chutes and policies will be decided by the superintendent and/or assistant superintendent.
