

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A
COURT ORDER TO AMEND A WISCONSIN MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE**
(F-05093)

1. When do I need a court order to change information on a marriage certificate?
You need to obtain a court order to correct information on a marriage certificate if:
 - a. You have received a packet of information from the State Vital Records Office (including this instruction page and the F-05093 Court Order to Amend a Wisconsin Marriage Certificate form) informing you that you need a court order to correct the erroneous information.
 - b. The marriage occurred over 1 year (365 days) ago, **OR**
 - c. A correction has already been made to that same item on the certificate. For legal purposes, a name (first, middle and last name) constitutes one item. Therefore if one part of a name is corrected, another part of the name cannot be corrected without a court order.
2. How do I get a court-ordered amendment for a marriage certificate?
 - a. Make arrangements to petition the Clerk of Court in the county where the marriage occurred.
 - b. Make sure you have a current certified copy of the marriage certificate showing how it now reads (with the incorrect information). You must present the current certified marriage certificate copy to the court in order to process your case.
 - c. Assemble the evidence for the amendment to be made.
 - d. Examples of evidence:
 - 1) A certified copy of the marriage license application form showing the correct information given to the County Clerk.
 - 2) Notarized affidavit from the officiant who performed the marriage verifying the requested amendment.
 - 3) Current certified copy of a birth certificate, marriage certificate, or other pertinent official documents verifying the requested amendment.
 - e. Complete the front and the pertinent sections of the back of the F-05093 Court Order to Amend a Wisconsin Marriage Certificate form.
3. Take the following items to court:
 - a. Petition
 - b. Current certified copy of the marriage certificate
 - c. Evidence which you have assembled that verifies the correct information
 - d. F-05093 Court Order to Amend a Wisconsin Marriage Certificate form (with the pertinent portions completed)
4. If the judge is satisfied with the evidence, he or she will sign the Court Order to Amend a Wisconsin Marriage Certificate form and have the court seal put on it.
5. **Send the following to the State Vital Records Office (address at the bottom of this sheet).**
 - a. **The form (F-05093 Court Order to Amend a Wisconsin Marriage Certificate) signed and sealed by the court (It must contain a court case number, the original signature of the judge and the court seal.)**
 - b. **\$10.00 amendment filing fee.** This fee does not include an amended copy of the marriage certificate.
 - c. If you want certified copies of the amended marriage certificate from the State Vital Records Office, **you must also send the fees for those copies** (\$20.00 for the first copy, \$3.00 for each additional copy ordered at the same time as the first copy).
 - d. Do not send the certified copy of the marriage certificate (unless the State Vital Records Office has instructed you to) or the evidence used to change the marriage certificate.
6. After our office processes the amendment, the amended marriage certificate will also be on file at the Register of Deeds in the county in which you were married. If you choose, you may wait and obtain your copies from that office. However, if you do not order the copies from the State Vital Records Office, our office will not notify you when the amendment has been completed.
7. **IMPORTANT.** The amendment will NOT BE PROCESSED if:
 - The F-05093 Court Order to Amend a Wisconsin Marriage Certificate form contains erasures, cross-outs, write-overs, correction fluid, or correction tape
 - The F-05093 Court Order to Amend a Wisconsin Marriage Certificate form does not have:
 - The Judge's signature
 - The court case number
 - The court seal
 - A listing of the evidence that was shown to the judge as proof of the changes sought
 - The \$10.00 fee is not included
