NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of the Circuit Court is directed to immediately enter a full satisfaction of the judgment on the judgment and lien docket. The funds deposited by the judgment debtor will stay on deposit with the Clerk of Circuit Court until claimed by the judgment creditor or, if no claim is made by judgment creditor in the statutory time period prescribed in Wis. Stat. § 59.66, the Clerk of Court shall turn the unclaimed funds over to the State as directed by law.
