Cathy DeLain presented the "County Retained Fee/Grant Report" covering funds collected and spent under Wisconsin State Statute 16.967(7) and 59.72(5) from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016. Kristi Tuesburg gave a report on the recent activities in the Register of Deeds Office:

- Kayla Sheahan was appointed Deputy, Register of Deeds in January 2017.
- Kassandra Smith has been hired as a part-time employee, working afternoons.
- Kassandra will be working full-time in the summer.
- Real Estate recordings are up in 2017 by 221 documents in the first six months.
- Internet sales are up in 2017 by \$348 in the first six months.
- RPL has been given access to the Register of Deeds Deketo system.
- RPL also receives the E-Return receipts via email daily.

Cathy DeLain reported on activities in the GIS Office:

- The county flew new air photos on April 22-23 with a new vendor, Pictometry. They specialize in taking oblique imagery in additional to the traditional orthogonal (straight down) view. We have multiple methods for viewing the oblique images:
 - 1) CONNECTExplorer a cloud based application hosted by Pictometry.
 - 2) Pictometry Viewer a light Flex application on our GIS websites.
 - 3) Pictometry for ArcGIS Server a more robust Flex application on our Advanced Access GIS website.
 - 4) Tyler Technologies Pictometry module part of the software upgrade happening in the Joint Dispatch Center later in 2017.

Seventy local users attended training on CONNECTExplorer on May 10-11. In the last 30 days we had 178 logins, 1712 image views, and 198 searches. We are unable to track usage from the GIS websites.

 Our \$50,000 WLIP Strategic Initiative Grant application for 2017 was due in December, 2016. We are using it to improve data and publication methods based on last year's mandated parcels and zoning data submission submission (\$5000) and to pay for the Pictometry flight (\$45,000). Our \$2936 Base Budget Grant will go towards the Treasurer's Tax Bill Web Integration project. The \$1000 Training and Education Grant will be used to send county employees to land records related conferences.

The next Land Information Council meeting will be scheduled when needed.

9 key Element Plan Development: Jerry Halverson informed the committee of possible funding for plan development for the Pine Creek sub-watershed in Manitowoc County. 9 key element plans provide a framework for improving water quality in a holistic manner within a geographic watershed. Plan development would assess the contributing causes and sources of nonpoint source pollution and prioritize restoration and protection strategies to address water quality problems.

Multi Discharger Variance Process: Jerry Halverson presented information on the variance process. A multi-discharger variance is a time extension for point sources facing restrictive phosphorus limits and provides an opportunity for point sources to make payments to county Soil and Water Conservation Departments at a rate of \$51.10 per pound times the number of pounds of phosphorus their discharge exceeds the target value. The county then utilizes the funds for staff and cost sharing with land owners willing to apply best management practices on their land that reduce phosphorus runoff to surface water.

Animal Waste Ordinance -

A. Update of Violations: A violation in the Town of Meeme on June 27, 2017 for mechanically applied manure that ran off of an application site and entered an agricultural shoreland corridor.

Natural Resource Conservation Service 2017 Program Update.

Farm Service Agency Report – Terri Wilfert informed the committee that crop reporting deadline was July 17, 2017. Reporting can still be done but a filing fee will be charged. Election for a committee member representing the middle area of the county will take place in August. Next FSA meeting will be on August 2, 2017

Chairperson Cathy Wagner called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Roll Call: Cathy Wagner, Todd Holschbach, Larry Bonde, Dave Gauger, and Melvin Waack were present. Terri Wilfert was excused and Nick Muench was absent.

Also in attendance were: Jerry Halverson and Bruce Riesterer - Soil & Water Conservation Dept.

Agenda: Motion to approve the Agenda was made by Todd Holschbach and seconded by Larry Bonde. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Minutes: Motion was made by Melvin Waack and seconded by Todd Holschbach to approve the July 20, 2017 and August 17, 2017 minutes. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Public Comment:

Richard Ward, 15107 Point Creek Road, spoke in support of retaining Manitowoc County Feeding Deer Prohibited ordinance. He stated that there is no good science base to determine that Chronic Wasting Disease will not spread to domestic livestock.

Scott Mayer, 841 Maple Street, Cleveland spoke in opposition of the Feeding Deer Prohibited ordinance. He stated that there is no good science that Chronic Wasting Disease spreads to domestic livestock. Other states that ban baiting have witnessed the spread of Chronic Wasting Disease. It is a challenge to lure deer into a swamp during hunting season without baiting when you are competing with food plots and other food sources.

Bob Schuh, 9204 County K, Whitelaw representing Manitowoc County Fish and Game Protective Association, spoke in support of retaining the Feeding Deer Prohibited ordinance. Fish and game board unanimously support the ordinance.

Bob Schuh speaking for himself, also supports retaining the ordinance because there are too many un-knowns.

Bob Schuh also relayed a statement on behalf of David Reich, who thinks that baiting should be allowed on private land but prohibited on public land.

Steve Naas, 7212 County Rd. C, spoke in support of retaining the Feeding Deer Prohibited ordinance. He stated that true sportsmen should do their homework prior to the hunting season and can harvest deer without baiting.

Chuck Hoffmann, 2020 Steiners Corner Rd. Two Rivers, County Board Supervisory District No. 20, stated that he does not have a preference either way if the county should retain or rescind the Feeding Deer Prohibited ordinance. He has had twenty contacts on this issue. Five were against baiting and fifteen for baiting. Does the Sheriff's Dept. have time to enforce the ordinance? Where in the budget will enforcement costs come from? We should move slowly before we allow baiting again. The Department of Natural Resources should enforce this. The rule should be consistent county to county.

Dan Cichantek, 2917 S. 21st St. representing Manitowoc County Fish and Game Protective Association, spoke in support of retaining the Feeding Deer ordinance. The board representing approximately 3,200 members, passed a unanimous vote to retain the feeding ban. Biologically, is feeding beneficial to the deer? In the early 80's and into the 90's when we did allow baiting, what happened to our deer herd?

Mike Mecca, Manitowoc, spoke in opposition of the Feeding Deer Prohibited ordinance. He prefers to put mineral out in the spring to improve the health of the deer herd. For Manitowoc County to be 1 of 10 counties that cannot bait, doesn't make sense.

Rick Gerroll, 1631 Skyline Drive, County Board Supervisory District No. 21 spoke in opposition of the Feeding Deer Prohibited ordinance. He received two calls on this: one for and one against. Who and how will this be enforced? There is so much deer food around, how will 2 ½ gallons make any difference. How are food plots any different than baiting.

Chris Malchek, 5815 Two Creeks Rd. spoke in opposition of the Feeding Deer Prohibited ordinance. If you don't want to bait them, don't do it. The state now says it's ok to bait. Now the county will have to enforce it.

Manitowoc County Ordinance 6.295 Feeding Deer Prohibited: Motion was made by Melvin Waack and seconded by Cathy Wagner to recommend that the County Board of Supervisors rescind County Ordinance 6.295. Upon vote, the motion failed with 2 ayes and 3 noes.

Soil and Water Resource Management Grant Program/Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program—Cost-Share Contracts, Agreements and Amendments:

Motion was made by Todd Holschbach and seconded by Larry Bonde to approve the Soil and Water Resource Management contracts and the Conservation Reserve Program amendments and agreements as presented. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Budget Review: Reviewed annual budget ending July 31, 2017.

Vouchers: Motion to approve the list of vouchers was made by Dave Gauger and seconded by Todd Holschbach. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Lake Michigan Day: Todd Holschbach stated that over 100 people attended the fourth annual Lake Michigan Day on August 11th at the Maritime Museum. The featured speaker was Cameron Davis, the Obama Administration's liaison to Congress on Great Lakes issues. Coastal city mayors from Manitowoc south to Racine gave reports on projects funded by the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative.

9 - Key Element Plan Development: Jerry Halverson informed the committee that funding for plan development for the Pine Creek sub-watershed in Manitowoc County will be allocated soon. 9 Key Element Plans provide a framework for improving water quality in a holistic manner within a geographic watershed. Plan development would assess the contributing causes and sources of nonpoint source pollution and prioritize restoration and protection strategies to address water quality problems.

Total Maximum Daily Load Plan Development: Jerry Halverson informed the committee that the next meeting to discuss program development will be on September 20, 2017 at 1:30 pm in the Soil & Water Dept. conference room. Funding for plan development is included in the State Joint Finance Committee proposed biennial budget.
