PLANTER
GUIDELINES**

1. Size of planter: 15 to 22 inches in diameter.
2. Soil, live plants, live flowers and any other materials you wish to use is your responsibility. No artificial flowers.
3. Decorate the planters. Be creative and be sure to have your club's name displayed (ex: a wooden sign placed in the planter, wood burn your club's name on the planter, etc.)
4. Be sure your club's name is written on the bottom of the planter.
5. Bring planters to the west door of Exhibition Building on Sunday, **August 22**, from noon to 4pm or Monday, **August 23** by 5pm.
6. Planters will be judged in the following categories:
 - a. Fair Theme
 - b. Fair Colors
 - c. Most Eye Appealing
 - d. Most Colorful
 - e. Most Creative
 - f. Identification of Club
7. Planters will need to be checked and watered by the participating 4-H club. Please designate someone from your club to care for the planter during fair week.
8. Release of planters will be Sunday, **August 29**, at the west end of the Exhibition Building from 6:30pm to 8:30pm or may be picked up from 9am to 3pm on Monday, **August 30**.
9. Planters must be picked up by the Friday following fair week or planters will be discarded.

- Please take your planter at the end of fair.
- Thought – If you place styrofoam peanuts in the bottom half of the planter, it will not be as heavy as using all soil.
