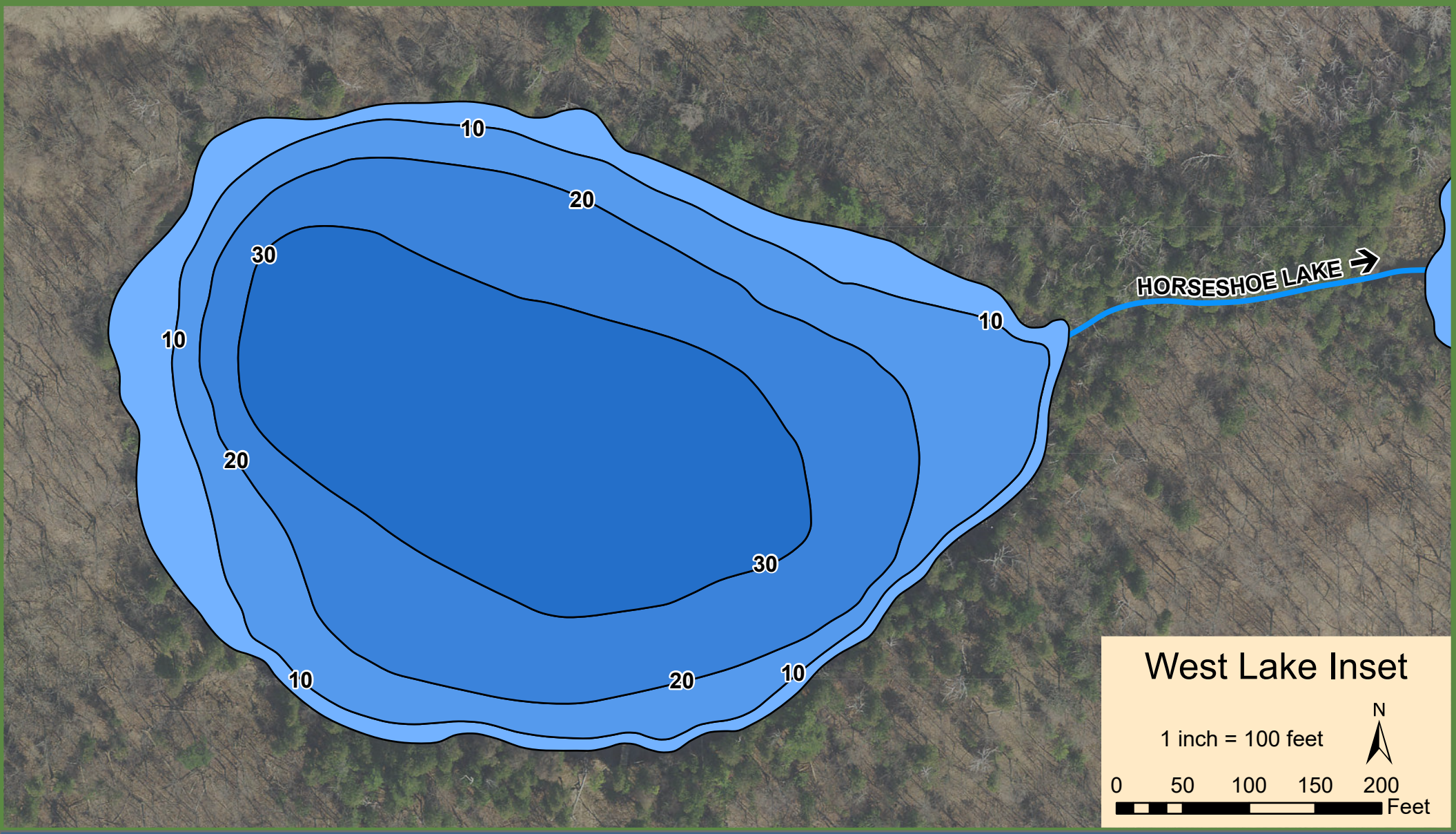
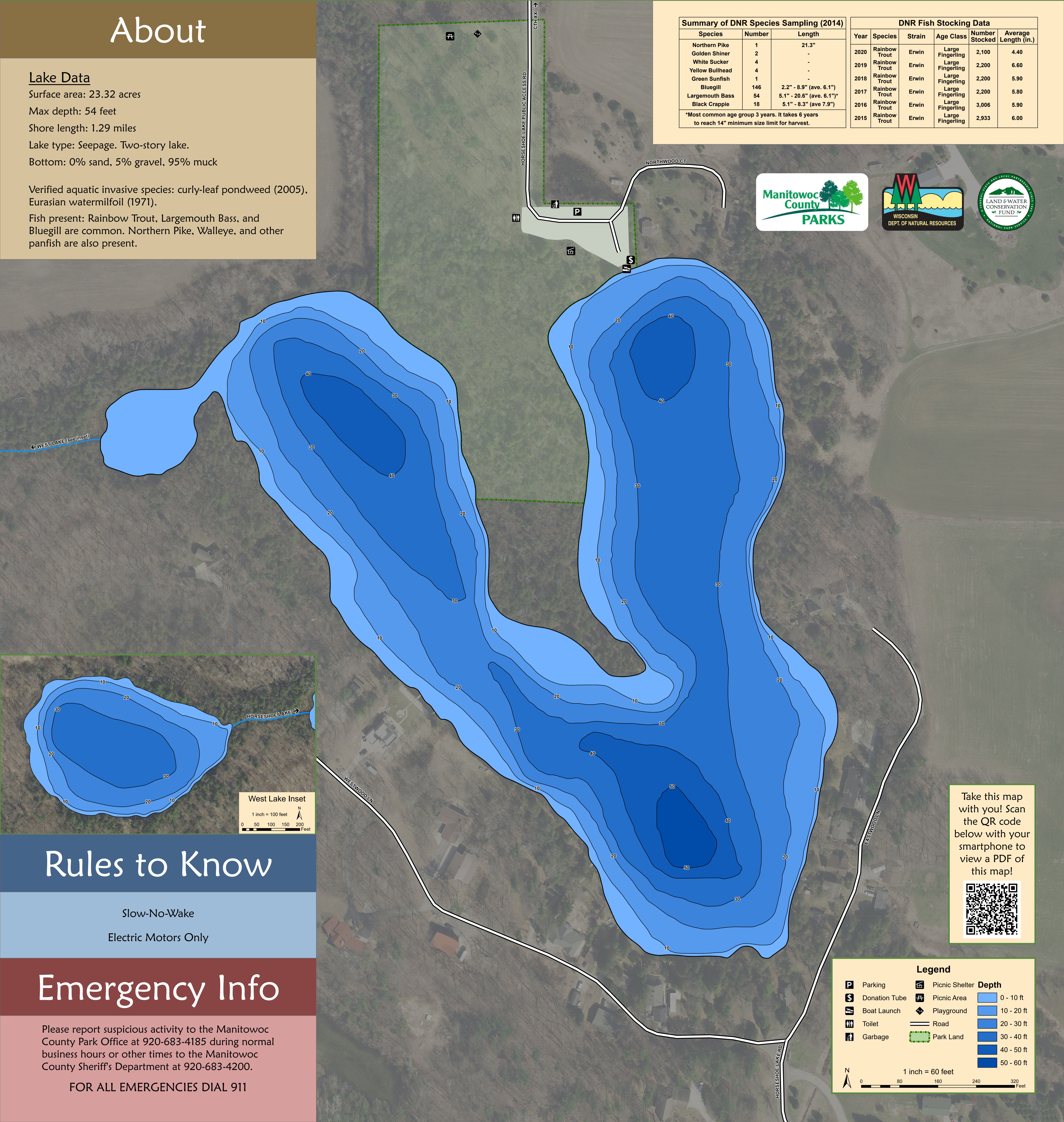
Lake Data

Surface area: 23.32 acres
Max depth: 54 feet
Shore length: 1.29 miles
Lake type: Seepage. Two-story lake.
Bottom: 0% sand, 5% gravel, 95% muck

Verified aquatic invasive species: curly-leaf pondweed (2005), Eurasian watermilfoil (1971).
Fish present: Rainbow Trout, Largemouth Bass, and Bluegill are common. Northern Pike, Walleye, and other panfish are also present.
