Manitowoc Minute's Charlie Berens Vaccinated at Manitowoc County Vaccine Clinic

The Manitowoc County Health Department enjoyed a special guest today at its COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic. Manitowoc Minute's Charlie Berens came to get his first dose of the Moderna Vaccine.

Joking that he came for the "free shots," Charlie asked if the Department was serving bourbon or whiskey. Upon hearing that we only had the COVID-19 vaccine on tap, he decided to settle on "da COVID deal" and was vaccinated shortly thereafter.

Beginning next week, all individuals 16 and older* in Wisconsin will be eligible for the COVID-vaccine. The Health Department encourages you to 'keep 'er moving,' by signing up to get vaccinated as soon as possible.

*Pfizer is the only vaccine currently authorized for use in people 16 and 17 years old. Individuals must be 18 or older to receive the Moderna or Johnson and Johnson vaccine.
