The Manitowoc County Health Department will be administering Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccines in Mishicot and Whitelaw this week. The Health Department will also be collaborating with Advocate Aurora Health to provide Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccines at the Manitowoc Farmer's Market. Please see details below:

Whitelaw

Where: St. Michael's Church lawn

Date: Thursday, June 10th

Time: 10:00AM – 2:00 PM

Manitowoc

Where: Manitowoc Farmers Market

Quay Street parking lot (across from the Manitowoc Public Library)

Date: Saturday, June 12th

Time: 8:00AM – 1:00 PM

All COVID-19 vaccines are available at no cost, regardless of whether or not you have health insurance. Individuals must be 18 or older to receive the Johnson and Johnson vaccine, which will be the only vaccine offered at these clinics. This vaccine is a single dose, meaning that participants will not have to return for a second dose.

After a thorough safety review, the FDA and CDC recommend the Johnson & Johnson vaccine resume and confirmed their confidence in its safety and effectiveness.
