Manitowoc County Health Department Welcomes Wisconsin National Guard to Administer Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine Boosters

Manitowoc County Health Department is pleased to welcome Wisconsin National Guard (WING) to Manitowoc to assist with COVID-19 boosters. WING will be operating mass vaccination clinics at the Manitowoc Expo grounds for the first three weeks of November to administer Moderna booster shots to eligible populations. Appointments are required.

MODERNA Booster Shots are available to the following populations:

Individuals who completed the **MODERNA** primary series **at least 6 months ago** and are:

- 65 year and older
- Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Age 18+ who work in high-risk settings
- Age 18+ who live in high-risk settings

Individuals who received a single dose of **JOHNSON AND JOHNSON** vaccine **at least 2 months ago**
