

Manitowoc County Fair Planter Guideines



"Summer Nights & Carnival Lights"

- 1. Size of planter: 15 to 22 inches in diameter.
- 2. Soil, live plants, live flowers and any other materials you wish to use is your responsibility. No artificial flowers.
- 3. Decorate the planters. Be creative and be sure to have your club's name displayed (ex: a wooden sign placed in the planter, wood burn your club's name on the planter, etc.)
- 4. Be sure you club's name is written on the bottom of the planter.
- 5. Bring planters to the west door of Exhibition Building on Sunday, **August 21**, from noon to 4pm or Monday, **August 22** by 5pm.
- 6. Planters will be judged in the following categories:
 - a. Fair Theme
 - b. Fair Colors
 - c. Most Eye Appealing
 - d. Most Colorful
 - e. Most Creative
 - f. Identification of Club
- 7. Planters will need to be checked and watered by the participating 4-H club. Please designate someone from your club to care for the planter during fair week.
- 8. Release of planters will be Sunday, **August 28**, at the west end of the Exhibition Building from 6:30pm to 8:30pm or may be picked up from 9am to 3pm on Monday, **August 29**.
- 9. Planters must be picked up by the Friday following fair week or planters will be discarded.

The County Fair Theme: 2022 Manitowoc County Fair -"Summer Nights & Carnival Lights" Fair Colors: Orange, Yellow and Royal Blue

- Please take your planter at the end of fair.
- Thought If you place styrofoam peanuts in the bottom half of the planter, it will not be as heavy as using all soil.
