About

The park consists of 84 acres divided into two distinct areas: a developed upland area and a natural lower area with 2,040 feet of Manitowoc River frontage.

Picnicking, hiking, and nature walks are popular activities. The park also offers a disc golf course. The removal of the dam at Manitowoc Rapids has allowed the Manitowoc River to be managed as a rainbow trout fishery.

Rules to Know


The removal of any items such as rocks, trees, shrubs, plants, or other natural growth is prohibited.

Hunting or trapping is prohibited.

The discarding of any refuse such as garbage, sewage, trash, or waste material in a manner other than in receptacles provided for such purposes is prohibited.

The dumping or disposal of waste material generated off-site is prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to start, tend, or maintain any fire, or to burn any refuse, except at designated fireplaces within the park except that: Fires for cooking or heating may be made in portable stoves, heaters, or grills at designated picnic areas. Dogs remaining on a leash are permitted. All animal waste must be collected and removed. Motor vehicles, bicycles, and horses are prohibited. Violent, abusive, loud, boisterous, vulgar, lewd, wanton, obscene, indecent, profane, or otherwise disorderly conduct is prohibited. River
