## OPEN CLASS POULTRY

1. Open Class Registration Deadline – **July 15**.
2. Entry Day – **Wednesday, August 23**, doors will open at 8am in the Poultry and Rabbit Building. All exhibits must be in place by 6pm.
3. Judging Day– **Friday, August 25**, starting at 9am.
4. Release Day – **Sunday, August 27**, from 5:30pm to 8pm. Claim checks will be required to have your poultry released. Cages must be completely cleaned at the conclusion of fair. Failure to do so could result in loss of premium.
5. Coop Rent – A rent of \$.50 per bird will be charged for cooping and supervision, paid at the time of registration. You must provide your own feed and feed birds daily.
6. No more than one (1) bird of any breed can be entered per lot number per class per exhibitor.
7. Class will include the following: old roosters, old hens, **2023** young roosters and **2023** young hens. An exhibit shall consist of birds hatched after **January 1, 2023** (young roosters & young hens). Any birds hatched prior to **2022**, are classified old roosters and old hens.
8. **Please contact the superintendent by August 1, if exhibitor has a large breed that requires a double cage. ANY EXHIBITOR THAT MAKES CAGE ALTERATIONS WITHOUT APPROVAL FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT WILL FORFEIT THEIR PREMIUMS.**
9. **Exhibitor MUST notify the superintendent by August 1, the number of birds and breeds.**
10. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** See WI County, District, & State Fairs **2023** Animal Health Rules and Regulations located on the website. Any required health certificates/copies must remain in the Expo office during the fair.
11. **PULLORUM Testing – All poultry except pigeons must be certified Pullorum-Typhoid free. Exhibitors must have proof that their birds are pullorum free when bringing them in on entry day. Exhibitor must also submit a copy for permanent record.** When purchasing young birds, ask for paperwork (documentation) stating the animal is pullorum free. Birds must be tested at least three (3) weeks prior to the Fair. **Testing is available by the Manitowoc County Poultry and Rabbit Committee. Please see page 4 of rules for dates and details. Anyone not having proof of testing cannot bring birds into the fair. This is a federal law. No testing will be done at fair**
12. **Turkeys will still need to provide proof of MG Testing.**
13. All birds, including ducks, geese and turkeys, must be banded with a number leg band. Leg bands can be purchased from the Superintendents. A list of numbers and colors should be supplied to the Superintendent on Entry Day.
14. The American Standard of Perfection shall govern all specimens entered in this department and will be judged by comparison. Any entries not fitting the class will be disqualified.
15. No crossbred birds in purebred classes.
16. The Manitowoc County Fair will not be responsible for any loss or damage to stock, but will exercise reasonable care in caring for exhibits.
17. Exhibitors are encouraged to secure cages to prevent vandalism. (Must be unlocked on Judging Day).
18. Each exhibitor must furnish their own feed, provide bedding, as well as clean and care for their own poultry on a daily basis. Please use shavings only as bedding in cages. Straw, hay, or cedar **MUST NOT** be used for bedding.
19. Geese, Turkey, and Duck cages must be cleaned daily.
20. **NO ANIMAL(S) SHALL BE SOLD IN OR FROM THE POULTRY AND RABBIT BUILDING DURING THE FAIR. A BULLETIN BOARD IS PROVIDED FOR ADVERTISING OF ANIMALS. ANY ANIMAL SELLING CAN BE DONE ON SUNDAY AFTER 6PM.**
21. **The Poultry and Rabbit Building will be open: Wednesday through Friday at 8am; Saturday and Sunday at 9am.**

## PULLORUM TESTING by the Manitowoc County Poultry & Rabbit Committee

PULLORUM Testing – **All poultry** except pigeons must be certified Pullorum-Typhoid free. Exhibitors must have proof that their birds are pullorum free when bringing them in on entry day at the Manitowoc County Fair. **Exhibitor must also submit a copy for permanent record.** When purchasing young birds, ask for paperwork (documentation) stating the animal is pullorum free. Birds must be tested at least three (3) weeks prior to the Fair.

No testing will be done at fair.** There will be no fee charged for Junior Fair Exhibitors. **Please Note: The Poultry and Rabbit committee and Manitowoc County Expo are not responsible for testing outside of the specified dates and times listed above. All testing must be done by July 31. Must bring premise ID number on testing dates**
