Communicable Disease Control

Disease Control & Prevention

Investigate, follow-up, and conduct surveillance for communicable diseases. Educate on disease control and prevention measures.



Public Health Emergency Preparedness

Plan, prepare and respond to public health emergencies, including communicable disease outbreaks through a preparedness program.

Chronic Disease & Injury Prevention

Healthiest Manitowoc County (HMC)

Collaborate with community partners to assess community needs, identify health priorities, and implement evidence based programs and policies to positively impact the health of our community. HMC spans all sectors of health including, social and economic factors, clinical care, physical environment, health outcomes, and health behaviors.

Narcan Training

Train community members how to recognize an opioid overdose and administer Narcan.



Access to & Linkage with Clinical Care

Free or Low Cost Screenings and Services

Offer **pregnancy testing, TB skin testing, and lead case management**. Some services are restricted to individuals who meet specific criteria. Please call for additional information regarding eligibility and availability.

Immunizations

Provide education, information, and administration of select vaccines to eligible children (VFC) and adults (VFA). Host a **free immunization clinic** for individuals under the age of 19 and who meet one of the following criteria:

- Uninsured
- Underinsured (insurance doesn't cover vaccines)
- Medicaid Eligible
- American Indian or Alaskan Native

Community Resource

Provide assistance and referrals to programs addressing needs with food, housing, child growth & development, school supplies, parenting support, clothing, vision & hearing screenings, and immunizations.

Maternal, Child, & Family Health Women, Infant, and Children (WIC)

Helps eligible families stay healthy and strong by **supplementing nutritious foods** approved by WIC, providing nutrition, meal planning, and shopping **assistance from a nutritionist**, and offering **breastfeeding education and support** from a lactation consultant.

Private Well Testing

Free private well testing for families with a pregnant woman or infant living in the household.
