1. Judging Day (Individual Conference Judging) – **Monday, August 19**, as follows: 10am to 2pm, and 2:30pm to 6pm in the Exhibition Building.
2. Release Day – **Sunday, August 25**, between 6pm and 7:30pm. Vehicle access begins at 6:30pm. **Exhibits released prior to release date and time will not receive premiums.**
3. No changes will be allowed after the registration forms are submitted.
4. **Four (4) entries or exhibits per class per exhibitor.**
5. **One (1) entry per exhibitor per lot number.**
6. Entry tags must be attached to the lower left hand corner. Identify all “any other” exhibit on entry tag and registration form.
7. Members enrolled in Knitting and Crocheting projects are eligible to exhibit their articles in the Clothing Revue (see department 26 – Clothing Revue, lot numbers 154-169).
8. All “any other” entries must be listed on the registration form and entry tag.
