1. Judging Day (Individual Conference Judging) – **Monday, August 19**, as follows: 10am to 2pm, and 2:30pm to 6pm in the Exhibition Building.
2. Release Day – **Sunday, August 25**, between 6pm and 7:30pm. Vehicle access begins at 6:30pm. **Exhibits released prior to release date and time will not receive premiums.**
3. **Four (4) entries or exhibits per class per exhibitor.**
4. **One (1) entry per exhibitor per lot number.**
5. Entry tags must be stapled to the lower left hand corner. Identify all “any other” exhibit on entry tag and registration form.
6. Entry tags must be attached to all items entered.
7. No changes will be allowed after the registration forms are submitted.
8. Bulletin boards, wall hangings, and pictures **MUST be suitable for hanging.**
9. Prepare to discuss in which room the article will be placed.
10. Pictures may be used for posters and scrapbooks.
11. Item must be made within the year.
12. Items may not be brought back the next year.
13. Items should not be soiled or worn.
