COUNTY DEPARTMENT DESCRIPTIONS

ADRC (Aging and Disability Resource Center) of the Lakeshore: Information and support for individuals 60 years and older regarding: nutrition, transportation, health benefits, legal services, home chores, financial assistance, mental health, disability issues, long-term care, housing, and options counseling; Select services and general information for individuals who are disabled over the age of 18.

<u>Airport Manager</u>: Oversees navigational aids, runways, taxiways, all blacktop areas, airport leases, all-season maintenance, construction, and is a resource on airport rules and regulations.

<u>Child Support</u>: Child support enforcement and collection; paternity establishment.

Clerk of Circuit Court: Maintains records management system for all court documents, records and exhibits for circuit courts. Provides support personnel for the circuit courts and court commissioners in traffic, criminal, civil, small claims, family, paternity and juvenile matters. Responsible for initiating new case filings and maintaining judgment/lien docket; collection and disbursement of various fees, fines and forfeitures; qualifying, selecting and notifying jurors for service to the three circuit courts; contracting with interpreters to provide language and/or hearing impaired interpretation services for court proceedings.

<u>Coroner</u>: Death investigation, cremation permits, disinterment permits, inservice education.

<u>Corporation Counsel</u>: Provides necessary civil legal services to Manitowoc County government and its boards, commissions, committees, councils, departments, employees, officers, offices, and officials with respect to their official duties. *Corporation Counsel represents the legal interests of Manitowoc County government, but does not represent or provide legal advice to businesses, individuals, or other municipalities.*

<u>County Clerk</u>: Marriage licenses, passports and passport photos, dog licensing program, County Board records, election records, notary service, county department mail, printing, county parking lot permits for the public, publishes the Official County Directory, Statistical Report of Property Values, and the County Board Proceedings Book. The County Clerk is also the Chief Election Officer of the County.

<u>County Executive</u>: The chief administrative and executive officer for the county. Coordinates and directs most administrative and management functions of the county, appoint and supervise the heads of most county departments, appoint the members of most Boards and Commissions, and submits the annual budget to the County Board. Responsible for approving or vetoing county resolutions and ordinances.

<u>District Attorney</u>: Prosecutes felony, misdemeanor and traffic crimes, County and State ordinance violations; handles delinquent sales tax violations for State of Wisconsin, and juvenile delinquency petitions for the county.

Emergency Management: County emergency response plans; disaster relief information; Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) facility plans; public education information; administrative office for Hazmat Team and Critical Incident Stress Management Team (CISM); headquarters for County Emergency Operations Center (EOC); speaker services; and emergency response training.

Expo-Ice Center: Home of the Manitowoc County Fair, and host to many other events including Dog Shows, Home Shows, Horse Shows, Motorcycle Shows, RV Rallies, Rummage Sales, Receptions, Festivals - to name a few. Also located on the fairgrounds is the Manitowoc County Ice Center, home to the Manitowoc County Youth Hockey Association / MCYHA Games and Manitowoc County Figure Skating Club / MCFSC Figure Skating Show, and public ice skating.

<u>Family Court Commissioner</u>: Provides services to all parties involved in legal actions affecting families.

<u>Finance Department</u>: Financial accounting and administration, accounts payable, accounts receivable, budgeting, general ledger, payroll, general purchasing, receipting and reporting. The office is also responsible for the County's property and liability insurance program.

<u>Health Department</u>: Women, Infant & Children (WIC) — Nutrition education program. Environmental Health — Ensure safe food, water & environment, Food Stand Permits. Public Health Nursing — Communicable disease control; immunizations; maternal-child health programs; access to health care; community health education & health screening; community health assessment and improvement planning.

<u>Highway Department</u>: Coordinate highway construction and maintenance on the county trunk system; perform maintenance on state trunk highway system (including I-43) in the county; perform maintenance and construction for other municipalities as requested; issue permits and approve work performed within highway right-of-way.

<u>Human Services Department</u>: Alcohol and drug abuse services; child protective services; mental health counseling; drug court services; substance use disorder treatment; childrens' developmental disabilities services; FoodShare Program; medical assistance; Wisconsin Shares Child Care Program; Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program; juvenile court services; adult protective services; guardianships; protective placements; and supportive home care.

<u>Information Systems</u>: Responsible for the administration, support and management of countywide information systems, including (but not limited to) server/network infrastructure, computer equipment/software, and information/data security. Manitowoc County Information System adheres to the mission of "delivering excellence in technology through innovation, strategic vision, and dedication to customer service."

<u>Joint Dispatch Center (JDC)</u>: Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) for 911 calls throughout Manitowoc County. Dispatching emergency and non-emergency calls for service is provided for law enforcement, fire, emergency medical services, emergency management and other public safety agencies.

<u>Parks</u>: Oversees the development and operation of the county's park system consisting of 5 major parks, 3 special purpose parks, 15 lake or river accesses spanning approximately 510 acres along with the 14 mile State recreation trail. Each of the 5 major county parks contain 75 to 160 acres providing a mix of passive recreational activities. With the cooperation of local snowmobile clubs, Manitowoc County manages the 248.35 miles of State funded trail and approximately 150 miles of club funded trail.

<u>Personnel</u>: Represents the county in all aspects of employment, including recruitment, policy development and administration, labor relations, benefit administration and compliance with state and federal employment laws and regulations.

Planning & Zoning: Administers the Parks Department, Real Property Lister, GIS System, Airport Height Limitations, General Zoning, Large Wind Energy Systems, Small Wind Energy Systems, Nonmetallic Mining Operations, Private Sewage Systems, Setbacks, Shoreland/Floodplain Zoning, Private Water Systems, Standards for Wireless Communications Facilities, and Subdivision/Certified Survey Regulations ordinances. Wisconsin Fund applications, Rezoning applications, Conditional Use and Variance applications, Farmland Preservation certificates, physical, socio & economic data and information, physical plans, mapping, County Wide Comprehensive Land Use Plan.

Public Works/Solid Waste/Public Safety Communications: General county building maintenance; telephone service; tax delinquent property management; county surplus equipment management; county bidding and purchasing procedures, county recycling programs; master solid waste agreement management; Clean Sweep programs; drug collection, composting; and mercury collection programs; county public safety radio infrastructure management; Expo grounds management; annual County Fair, and County Ice Center.

Register in Probate: Maintain court records of formal and informal estates; step-parent, private and agency adoptions; guardianships, conservatorships, protective placements and minor guardianships; mental, alcohol and drug dependent civil commitments.

Register of Deeds:

Vital Records Department: Birth, death and marriage records and certified copies. Statewide issuance for birth and marriage records. Genealogical research/family history.

Real Estate Department: Deeds, mortgages, satisfactions and any documents related to real estate. Subdivision plats, condominium plats, transportation project plats, and certified survey maps. Federal tax liens. Certified copies of DD-214s (Certificate of Release or Discharge From Active Duty).

<u>Sheriff</u>: Enforcement of state laws and county ordinances, supervise the county jail, secure juvenile detention, traffic control, process service, court security, criminal investigations, welfare fraud, special event security, prisoner and emergency medical detention transports.

<u>Soil and Water Conservation</u>: Responsible for the administration of ordinances to protect soil, surface water and ground water resources. Provides education, planning, engineering and cost share assistance for local and state conservation projects.

<u>Treasurer</u>: Collection of postponed and delinquent real estate taxes; deposits and invests monies belonging to the County; administers the lottery credit program and use value penalty; plat book sales; county tax-deeded property.

<u>Veterans Service Office</u>: Provides assistance to those who served in the U.S. Armed Forces and/or their dependents regarding benefits or problems.

Extension Manitowoc County - Agriculture: Provides research-based educational programs and technical support for agricultural producers and service providers. Educational programs are also offered to the general public as the need arises.

Extension Manitowoc County – Health and Well-Being: Promotes positive mental health strategies, individual and community education, and local coalition leadership. Prioritizing communities most impacted by inequities, the Health and Well-Being educator areas of focus include youth mental health, substance misuse and suicide prevention.

Extension Manitowoc County - 4-H Youth Development: Provides leadership training to adults and youth for traditional 4-H programs, and collaborates with schools and community-based youth programs.



THE WISCONSIN OPEN MEETINGS LAW

BECAUSE OUR GOVERNMENT BELONGS to the people, the Wisconsin Open Meetings Law, found in sections 19.81 through 19.98 of the Wisconsin Statutes, requires that public business, with certain exceptions, be conducted in public.

UNDER THE LAW, all meetings of governmental bodies are presumed to be open to the public unless the law specifically allows a closed session. The county board, its committees, boards, commissions, and agencies are governmental bodies. There are several reasons which allow for a closed session (found in Wis. Stat. §19.85). The most common instances are:

CONSIDERING PUNITIVE PERSONNEL ACTION against an employee of the body; Evaluating performance, compensation, promotion or employment of a public employee of the body; Considering strategies for crime prevention or detection; Conducting public business (such as purchasing property) where competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session; Considering information related to personal, social, medical or financial data of specific people where open discussion might injure their reputations; and Conferring with the attorney for the body to discuss litigation. Specific applications of these exemptions should be discussed with legal counsel in advance.

THE LAW REQUIRES that the public have notice of what will be discussed at meetings. This requires advance preparation of an agenda which gives a specific description of the matters to be discussed and acted upon by the body. The agenda must be prepared at least 24 hours before the meeting, except where urgent situations require less notice.

THE LAW ALSO FORBIDS use of secret ballots, except for the election of officers of a body. No body can convene privately to avoid the law — any gathering of a majority of the body is presumed to be a meeting. No body can meet in open session after going into closed session unless prior written notice has been provided.

THE BASIC RULE of the open meetings law is access by the public to conduct public business. Where any closed sessions are contemplated, care should be taken to assure that the spirit and intent of the open meetings law is being followed.

THE WISCONSIN LEGISLATURE consists of two houses, the Senate and the Assembly. The members of each house are elected by the people in the November general election from districts into which the state is divided by legislative act after each federal census.

SENATE - There are 33 senators who are elected for four year terms. The 16 senators who represent even-numbered districts, are elected in the years in which presidential elections occur, and the 17 who represent odd-numbered districts, are elected in the even-numbered years in which there are no presidential elections.

ASSEMBLY - There are 99 members in the Assembly who are elected for two-year terms.

Organization: Legislative officers are elected in each house. The Senate selects its leadership, the Majority and Minority Leaders, from among its members in a caucus. The Majority Leader is the manager of Senate business as authorized by the Senate Rules or by the Committee on Senate Organization. The corresponding officer in the Assembly is the Speaker, who is chosen by the members of the majority party.

EARLY HISTORY OF MANITOWOC COUNTY

Manitowoc County was originally occupied by Native Americans. French explorers claimed it for France, however, in the seventeenth century. They then ceded it to Great Britain in 1763 as a result of the French and Indian War. After the War of American Independence, one of the last acts of the Congress of Confederation was to establish it as part of the Northwest Territory. In 1809, the U.S. Congress made it part of Illinois Territory; and in 1818 it was attached to Michigan Territory. On April 20, 1836, it was included in Wisconsin Territory.

Manitowoc County was a part of Brown County until the organization of a separate county government for Manitowoc County was authorized by an act of the Territorial Legislature in 1836. Under the act, the date for the first election was scheduled for the first Monday in March, 1839. The Commissioners of Brown County were authorized to canvass the vote and issue certificates of election.

The election was held on March 4, 1839, at the home of P.P. Pierce in the Village of Manitowoc Rapids. Horace Conroe and O.C. Hubbard were Judges of Election, and Peter Johnson and J.H. Este, Clerks. Thirty-five votes were cast and the following officers were elected: County Commissioners, Horace Conroe, John Rigney and J.G. Conroe; Assessor, O.C. Hubbard; Register of Deeds, J.W. Conroe; Collector, Peter Johnson. Having received properly authenticated certificates of election, the County Commissioners met and organized on March 15, 1839. Meetings of the County Commissioners were recorded in the Journal of the County Commissioners, which is the first or earliest volume of the publication now known as the Proceedings of the County Board.

The next recorded meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held at Manitowoc Rapids, May 27, 1839, and it appears that the purpose of this meeting was to elect and appoint Judges of Election for Manitowoc County. Though the record states that Manitowoc County at that time was divided into two precincts, namely the Precinct of Conroe and the Precinct of Two Rivers, it does not describe what area constituted each voting ward. It is assumed, however, that no definite political lines were drawn, but that the electors of the County cast their votes in the polling place most convenient to reach at a time of few and poor roads and limited means of travel. The county seat was located at Manitowoc Rapids.

The name *munedoowk/manidoowaak* (Manitowoc) originated from the Ojibwe language, also known as Chippewa or Anishinaabe, and has been interpreted to mean "dwelling of the great spirit" or "habitation of good spirit" or "place of the good spirit."

HISTORY AND ORGANIZATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN MANITOWOC COUNTY

In 1848, the year Wisconsin was admitted to statehood, several changes took place affecting local government. On March 2, 1848, the Legislature enacted a law establishing a town system of government thus abolishing the county's Board of Commissioners.

But before its discontinuance, the last Board of Commissioners was comprised of Peter Poh, J.M. Sprague, and Albert Wheeler. Manitowoc County was comprised of four towns: Manitowoc, Manitowoc Rapids, Two Rivers, and Meeme. The first session of the County Board of Supervisors was held June 18, 1849 with the towns being represented as follows: Manitowoc, Andrew Vieu; Manitowoc Rapids, Charles McAllister; Two Rivers, John Stuart; Meeme, T. Cunningham. The Chairmen of the various towns constituted the County Board of Supervisors.

At this time, the north boundary line of Manitowoc County was the town line running between Towns 20 and 21 across Ranges 21, 22, 23, 24 and a fraction of Range 25. The division of the County into towns resulted in the formation of four towns: Two Rivers, Manitowoc, Manitowoc Rapids, and Meeme.

The Town of Two Rivers was comprised of all its present area, but also included parts of the Town of Mishicot in Town 20 - Range 24, as well as Sections 18, 19, 30 and 31 which are now a part of the Town of Kossuth. The Town of Manitowoc's boundaries are the same, with such territory as has been added to the City of Manitowoc. The Town of Manitowoc Rapids was comprised of all of the area that is now the Towns of Maple Grove, Rockland, Franklin, Cato, Manitowoc Rapids, and the greater part of Eaton, Liberty and Newton. The south boundary line of the Town of Manitowoc Rapids was the southwest corner of Section 19, Town 18, Range 21 and then East along the Section line across Ranges 21, 22 and 23 to that point where the section line intersects with the shore of Lake Michigan. All of Manitowoc County south of this line constituted the Town of Meeme.

As various parts of the County developed and were settled, petitions were presented to the Board of Supervisors asking that tracts be established as separate towns. By these steps, as recorded in the Proceedings of the County Board of Supervisors, the number of towns increased to the present number of eighteen.

The chronological order of the establishment of the last fourteen towns was as follows:

- 1850 -- Newton, Centerville, and Maple Grove
- 1851 -- Kossuth and Eaton. (In 1853, the name Eaton was changed to Walders. In 1854 it was changed back to Eaton.)
- 1852 -- Mishicot. (In May, 1853, the name Mishicot was changed to Saxonberg, but in November of the same year it was changed back to Mishicot.)
- 1855 -- Schleswig and Franklin
- 1856 -- Cooperstown and Rockland
- 1857 -- Liberty (originally named Buchanan from 1857 to 1861), and Cato.
- 1858 -- Gibson
- 1859 -- Two Creeks (originally named Rowley, changed to Two Creeks in 1861)

MANITOWOC

The Village of Manitowoc was incorporated under an act of March 6, 1851 with George Reed as the first village president. The two village wards were represented on the County Board by G. Kremers from the first ward, and C.W. Fitch from the second ward. A city charter was granted by the legislature March 12, 1870 with Peter Johnson being the first mayor.

TWO RIVERS

On March 31, 1858, a village charter incorporating the Village of Two Rivers was granted. H.C. Hamilton was chosen as the first village president; Wm. Aldrich and H.B. Allen represented the first and second wards, respectively, on the Manitowoc County Board. A city charter was granted March 18, 1878, with Michael Malloy being the first mayor.

On April 18, 1924, an election was held for the purpose of determining whether the city should adopt a council-manager form of government. Since the referendum favored the adoption of the council-manager form, on May 18, 1925, the City Council appointed Richard Biehl as the first city manager, his term of office becoming effective June 1, 1925. The city still operates under the council-manager system.

REEDSVILLE

The Village of Reedsville was incorporated as a village on January 29, 1892, Mr. W.H. Noble being its first president, and Mr. F.F. Stelling the first village supervisor on the County Board.

KIEL

The Village of Kiel was incorporated as such on June 12, 1892, with Charles Heins serving as the first village president and J.C. Mueller being the first County Board representative. Kiel became a city on December 15, 1920, with H.J. Ammann being elected as its first mayor.

VALDERS

The Village of Valders was incorporated by an order of the Circuit Judge of Manitowoc County on November 7, 1919. On January 13, 1920, the first village election was held, Wm. F. Christel being elected president and A. A. Lyken the first supervisor on the County Board.

MISHICOT

The Village of Mishicot was incorporated as a village on August 23, 1950. Hugo F. Holst was the first president and Reuben Harpt the first village supervisor.

ST. NAZIANZ

The Village of St. Nazianz was incorporated as a village on June 5, 1956. Ambrose L. Eberle was the first president as well as the first village supervisor.

WHITELAW

The Village of Whitelaw was incorporated as a village on May 23, 1958 with Emil J. Steeber as the first president and Jerome Martin the first supervisor.

CLEVELAND

The Village of Cleveland was incorporated as a village on November 6, 1958. Howard Vogel was the first president and William Rutherford the first supervisor.

FRANCIS CREEK

The Village of Francis Creek was incorporated as a village on June 24, 1960 with Matt J. Kocian, Jr. as the first president and Clifford Meyer the first supervisor.

MARIBEL

The Village of Maribel was incorporated as a village on September 12, 1963. Harvey Becker was the first president and Antone H. DeLorme the first supervisor.

KELLNERSVILLE

The Village of Kellnersville was incorporated as a village on July 1, 1971 with John Deets as the first president and Russell M. Steeber the first supervisor.

HISTORY OF MANITOWOC COUNTY COURTHOUSES

The first courthouse was located in Manitowoc Rapids in the year 1839. It was a 24' x 30' one story frame construction and cost \$650.00. Manitowoc County's population at the time was 240. On April 30, 1852 it was destroyed when an inmate who was adjudicated insane set fire to the jail which subsequently spread to the nearby courthouse.

In 1853 the county seat changed from Manitowoc Rapids to the Village of Manitowoc. After numerous delays in both selecting a site and securing a clear deed, the second courthouse was constructed on grounds of the present courthouse in 1857 for \$10,000. It was a three-story brick structure with a dome. The Sheriff and his family lived in the building where his quarters, office, and jail were located on the first floor, administrative county offices were on the second floor, and the third floor was the "hall of justice" courtroom. The second courthouse was in service until 1905 when it was decided that it was too small for the needs of the county. After the county was unable to sell the building, it was moved one block south to make room for the present (third) courthouse.

In November of 1904, the County Board unanimously approved a Beaux Arts, Neoclassical design presented by C.H. Tegen of Manitowoc. The original approval for the cost was not to exceed \$150,000. However, due to problems with concrete and digging the foundation, waiting for building materials, a strike by cement mixers, and the addition of "extras" such as: marble wainscoting, ornamental plastering, gas piping, heat regulation systems, stone balustrades, and more, the final cost to build the Courthouse was approximately \$238,348. At least two men died on separate occasions during the construction of the building.

The Manitowoc County Courthouse is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

- ➤ First Tuesday in January 5:00 p.m. is the deadline to file nomination papers for candidates running for office in the Spring Election. (Wis. Stat. § 8.10)
- ➤ Third Tuesday in February is the day of the Spring Primary Election, if required.
- ➤ The 1st Tuesday in April is the day of the Spring General Election. (Wis. Stat. § 10.66)
- April 15th is the earliest day nomination papers may be circulated for the August Primary (even numbered years includes independent candidates). (Wis. Stat. § 10.78)
- June 1st 5:00 p.m. is the deadline for filing nomination papers (includes independent candidates). (Wis. Stat. § 10.78)
- ➤ 2nd Tuesday in August in an even numbered year is the day for the Partisan Primary Election. (Wis. Stat. § 10.74)
- ➤ The Tuesday after the 1st Monday in November is the day of the General Election. (Wis. Stat. § 10.80)
