- 1. Open Class Registration Deadline July 15.
- 2. Entry Day Monday, August 19, from noon to 7pm, in the Exhibition building.
- 3. Judging Day Tuesday, August 20, at 10am.
- 4. Release Day **Sunday, August 25**, between 6pm and 7:30pm. Vehicle access begins at 6:30pm. **Exhibits released** prior to release date and time will not receive premiums.
- 5. Fee \$.10 per entry for each exhibitor and paid at the time of registration.
- 6. Exhibitor is limited to one (1) entry or exhibit per lot number.
- 7. All pictures must be adequately framed and **must** have permanent hangers or screws with wire ready to be hung.
- 8. Watercolors and pastels are preferred under glass.
- 9. All items must be made by the exhibitor.
- All possible care will be taken to prevent loss or damage to exhibits, but no responsibility for the same will be assumed.
- 11. The superintendent has the right to disqualify any item receiving a premium in previous years.
- 12. All "any other" items must be named on the registration form and entry tag.
- 13. Entries in this department may not be entered in Home Furnishings.
- 14. All cards to have envelopes.
