What is a Wetland Restoration?

It is a restoration of wetlands through wetland scraps, tile breaks, and the creation of berms to create surface water and provide wildlife habitat.

Why install a Wetland Restoration?

Wetland restorations trap and reduce the amount of sediment and nutrient runoff, as well as reduce flooding and provide beneficial wildlife habitat

Things to Consider

- Permits may be needed prior to construction
- Cost share may be available through other organizations
