Home Delivered Meals

Emergency Procedures:

- Participants are expected to be home at the time of the meal delivery.
- In the event a participant is unaccounted for, the following steps will be taken:
 - 1. The volunteer will contact the ADRC of the Lakeshore with this information.
 - 2.ADRC office staff will then attempt to contact the participant's emergency contacts, which the participant provided to the office for this purpose.
 - 3. If the emergency contact is unavailable or unable to follow up with the participant, a safety check will be requested of the local police/sheriff's department.

Snowstorm Procedure:

- If weather conditions are too severe to deliver meals, closings will be announced starting by 8:00 am on the following stations:
 - Radio:
 - Kewaunee County: WDOR
 - Manitowoc County: WOMT, WCUB, or WHBL
 - Television: WBAY or WFRV
- It is suggested that participants keep a special stock of emergency food in case of severe weather, with the following food:
 - Canned citrus or tomato juice
 - $\circ\,$ Dried or evaporated milk
 - Canned or dried soups
 - Canned meat or fish
 - $\circ\,$ Canned vegetables/fruits, such as beans, corn, peas, peaches, pears, etc.
 - Peanut butter
 - Crackers
 - Jam, jelly, or marmalade
 - Instant or ready-to-eat cereal
 - Instant coffee, tea, or cocoa
 - Bread and cheese
 - Bottled water
