

What to Expect When Coming to a Support Group

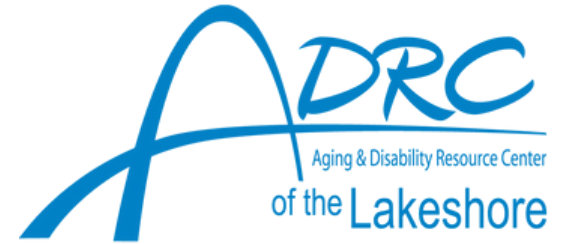
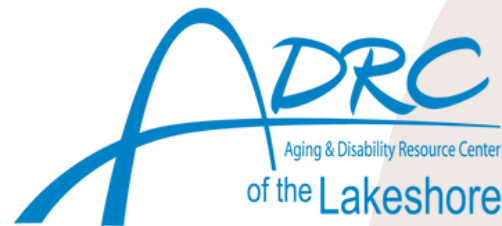

EARLY STAGES SUPPORT GROUP

Early Stages Support Group hosts two simultaneous groups - one meant for the caregivers and another for those affected by dementia in its early stages. Our Caregiver Specialist offers the space and support for caregivers, while our Dementia Care Specialist holds the space and support for those diagnosed.

An assessment is required prior to attending for the person diagnosed. Please contact the Dementia Care Specialist for assessment. Caregivers require no RSVP and may attend independently without the person diagnosed. Persons with diagnosis are strongly encouraged to attend with a caregiver.
