Disabled American Veterans (DAV)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides free rides to all veterans who need help getting to and from scheduled Veterans Administration (VA) appointments Serve major VA facilities in Madison, Milwaukee, Tomah, and Minneapolis, and VA clinics in Appleton, Green Bay, Superior, Union Grove, Wausau, and Wisconsin Rapids Each weekday, three vans depart from Green Bay to transport veterans to and from the Zablocki VA Medical Center in Milwaukee.
