- 1. Judging Day (Individual Conference Judging) **Monday, August 18**, as follows: 10am to 2pm, and 2:30pm to 6pm in the Exhibition Building.
- Release Day Sunday, August 24, between 6pm and 7:30pm. Vehicle access begins at 6:30pm. Vehicle access will begin at 6:30pm through the northwest corner of the Main Parking lot (across the street from Meijer). Watch for signs. Line Up begins at 6:25pm. Exhibits released prior to release date and time will not receive premiums.
- 3. Four (4) entries or exhibits per class per exhibitor.
- 4. One (1) entry per exhibitor per lot number.
