1. Judging Day (Individual Conference Judging) – Judging Day – Saturday, August 9, starting at 9am at the Manitowoc County Kennel Club – 40 Albert Drive, Manitowoc. Agility – 9:00am Showmanship – 11:30am Obedience – 12:30pm

Team Obedience to be judged after Obedience in the combined ring

- 2. To be eligible exhibits must be the result of a regular dog project work. Each member must have trained the dog which enters during the current year.
- 3. No changes will be allowed after registration forms are submitted.
- 4. Dogs will wear a collar and shall be led with a leather or fabric lead six (6) feet long. No prong collars or halti training aids allowed. Dogs will not be permitted off lead except when being judged. Exhibitors must keep dogs under control at all times. Showmanship lead (or show collar with show leash) must be used in all Showmanship classes.
- 5. All dogs are required to have had distemper, parvo, and rabies inoculations before being allowed to enter the fair. A copy of inoculations must be provided prior to fair judging to be placed on file in the Expo Office.
- 6. Female dogs in season will not be permitted to enter the ring, exhibitors should report to the ring alone and you will be judged separately.
- 7. Each dog is allowed to enter: Two (2) obedience classes; One (1) Sign Class and One (1) Non-Sign Class; Two (2) Agility classes (either on leash or off leash); 1 (one) brace class.
- 8. Dogs winning a first blue with a qualifying score of 170 or higher the previous year in Obedience, must show in a class higher the current fair year. Example - the dog wins the first blue in Beginners Novice A with a score of 170 or higher the previous year, exhibitor must show in Beginners Novice B the current fair year.
- 9. Individuals winning a First Blue in showmanship grades 5 and over must show in the Open Showmanship Class.
- 10. Agility Exhibitor may enter in Jumps-Tunnel-Table (JTT) and/or Standard. If exhibitor is entered on leash, exhibitor cannot enter in off leash, or if exhibitor entered in off leash, exhibitor cannot be entered in on leash.
- 11. No crates or cages in the building.
