Update on Communications System SOP's and Interoperability:

Mark Knier raised a concern with a letter that was sent out by Jeff Green (Theda Star). The letter introduced switching from Marc 2 channel to Fire Ground Black or Gray. There is push back from the pilots. A meeting is scheduled with WI Aero providers to discuss the change.

Capt. Wallander raised the issue of communication issues during vice presidential candidate Minnesota Gov. Tim Walz's October 28th visit to Manitowoc. State Patrol could not hear or speak on Inter-Ops 1, but other agencies could hear them when they talked. Bill Jones will look into the matter.
