The Soil & Water Conservation Department is tasked with supporting farming and protecting farmland with sensible oversight to protect soil and water resources. Manitowoc County has adopted the Livestock Facility License Ordinance – Chapter 28; to monitor and ensure expanding farms meet property setbacks, odor management, construction and waste runoff standards and allow for public input on farm expansion plans.

Farms applying for Livestock Facility Licenses in Manitowoc County are required to prepare and submit a 5-Year Nutrient Management Plan (NMP). As part of this plan, _____ Farm has maps identifying your land as available for the safe application of manure and waste over the next five years.

Signing this form confirms that you have been contacted and made aware your land listed will be available for the farm's planning purposes and application of animal waste over the next 5 years.
