1. Open Class Registration Deadline – **July 15**. Register online at fair.manitowocountywi.gov.
2. Entry Day – **Monday, August 24**, starting at noon and **MUST be placed no later than 7pm**, in the Exhibition building.
3. Judging Day – **Tuesday, August 25**, at 10am.
4. Release Day – **Sunday, August 30**, between 6pm and 7:30pm. **Vehicle access will begin at 6:30pm through the northwest corner of the Main Parking lot (across the street from Meijer). Watch for signs. Line Up begins at 6:25pm. Exhibits released prior to release date and time will not receive premiums.**
5. Fee - \$.20 per entry for each exhibitor and paid at the time of registration.
6. **Exhibitor is limited to one (1) entry or exhibit per lot number.**
7. All items must be made by the exhibitor.
8. All items must be hand-knit and hand-crocheted.
9. Soiled or damaged articles may not compete.
10. The Superintendent has the right to disqualify any entry receiving previous years.
11. All “any other” entries must be named on the registration form and entry tag.
