

Manitowoc County Public Safety Committee

March 11th, 2026, 5:00 p.m.

Attendance: Present: Chairperson James Falkowski, Supervisor Mike Grambow, Supervisor Dylan Hammel, Supervisor Dan Heilman and Supervisor Tim Jadowski.

Others in attendance: Supervisor Mickey Lillibridge, Supervisor Scott Schiesl, Board Chair Tyler Martel and Daniel Hartwig, Sheriff and Chief Deputy Jason Orth.

Chair James Falkowski called meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Roll call circulated.

Minutes of prior meeting: Chair Falkowski asked if there were any changes or corrections to the minutes of the February 11th, 2026, meeting. Offered to approve the minutes contingent with no changes posted.

A motion to approve the minutes by Supervisor Jadowski and second by Supervisor Hammel, all voting in favor.

Chair Falkowski noted that the monthly corrections report and monthly financials were sent to all members along with the grant applications on our agenda. There were no questions regarding the reports.

Supervisor Jadowski gave a brief report about the corrections report.

No Public comment registered.

Chair Falkowski introduced Sheriff Hartwig to present the Wisconsin DOJ grant application submitted by Lt Beck for Enhance and Facilitate DTR Investigation for \$50k. Another Wisconsin DOJ grant submitted by Lt. Oswald for Cellebrite and Hardware program for \$40k.

The Sheriff discussed how the grants are to be used; one for Investigation/evidence transportation coinciding with metro drug investigations The other grant is for mobile phone data access equipment and software for investigations. Currently about 100-150 phones per yr are involved with investigation.

After discussion, a motion to approve the resolution accepting the Wis DOJ Enhance and Facilitate DTR Investigations grant was made by Supervisor Hammel and second by Supervisor Grambow. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion to approve the resolution accepting the Wis DOJ Hardware and Cellebrite Program grant was made by Supervisor Jadowski and second by supervisor Heilman. Motion passed unanimously.

Both will be included in the county board's agenda for approval.

Our next scheduled meeting will be tentatively April 15th. Watch for announcements.

Motion to Adjourn by Supervisor Grambo seconded by Supervisor Hammel.
