Updates:

Drug Court: Ms. Keagle was presented information. 11 current participants consisting of 3 females and 8 males. 1 termination pending, and one admission pending. There is a graduation scheduled for May 6th. The team just got back from the annual WATCP State Conference. Good attendance by the team. This year was important as they focus to write a new grant for another 5 year cycle. This year is very competitive.

DA: No updates.

Jerry Mutchie: Explained the need and building of an Overdose Fatality Review Board to work closely with the Coroner's Office and be comprised of a limited number of representatives from all area agencies. The purpose is to reduce overdose deaths, reduce the stigma around addiction, and reduce treatment concerns, among others. The board will look to review and recommend/report findings at quarterly meetings. Chair Judge Rohrer opened discussion to bring a presentation to the next General Council meeting to then discuss the possibility of a CJCC Sub Committee. Jerry agreed to present such information at that meeting.
